Buyer's Responsibilities

Provide responsible love, which involves training. This requires a lot of time for the first year of the puppy's life and is a life-long commitment.

Have a fenced yard or play area for puppy, or agree to take puppy outside on a leash.

Provide the puppy with a high quality dog food, such as Victor, Diamond Naturals, or Taste of the Wild and fresh water.

Provide the puppy with routine health care, such as, but not limited to:

- Annual physical exams
- Follow veterinary guidelines for vaccinations and de-worming

Please use common sense and do not expose your puppy to other people's pets and avoid public "doggie areas" until the puppy has immunity from the series of vaccinations completed by your Vet.

Have the puppy examined by a Vet of your choosing within 72 hours of delivery.
If there is a health concern, the Buyer must notify Breeder immediately, by phone or email.

Please note that minor symptoms, such as runny nose or diarrhea, may be brought on by stress and change of food and/or water. It will take up to two weeks for the puppy to adjust to these changes.

Breeder's Guarantee

This puppy is guaranteed until his/her first birth date against fatal and life altering congenital diseases. This includes severe hip dysplasia, kidney, heart, pancreas, spine, and liver problems of a severe life threatening, or altering nature. If the dog dies within this one-year time frame, the Buyer agrees to have an autopsy to determine the reason. If the reason is congenital, the Breeder will replace the puppy or refund the purchase price (excluding shipping).

Breeder must be notified within 2 business days of the licensed veterinarian's determination. A second vet, independent of the first vet or his associates, must also document the diagnosis.

The breeder may ask for the puppy to be returned or euthanized to qualify for a replacement puppy. A returned puppy must be returned to the seller in good condition, other than the specified problem, at the buyer's expense. All paperwork, including Registration Papers and this form, must be returned with the puppy.

This guarantee applies to the original puppy and purchaser, and is not transferable to a second party. The breeder will not be responsible for any vet bills.

Replacement puppy will be mutually agreed upon by both parties and may or may not be from the exact parents of the original puppy.

There are certain disorders that may be caused by environmental factors, such as allergies, thyroid dysfunction, demodectic mange and other autoimmune disorders that are not covered by this guarantee. A dog's ability to breed is not guaranteed.

We run a responsible breeding program and follow up reports on our puppies are essential. Please feel free to contact us at any time. We abide by the Golden Rule.
